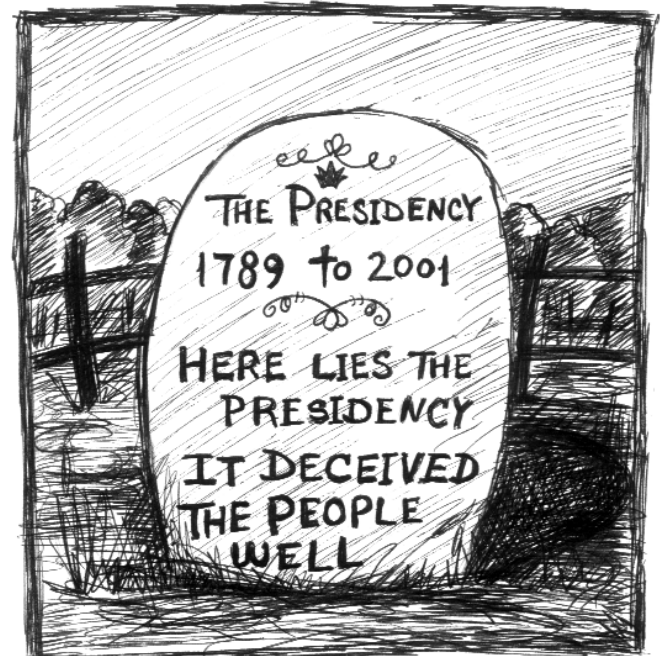

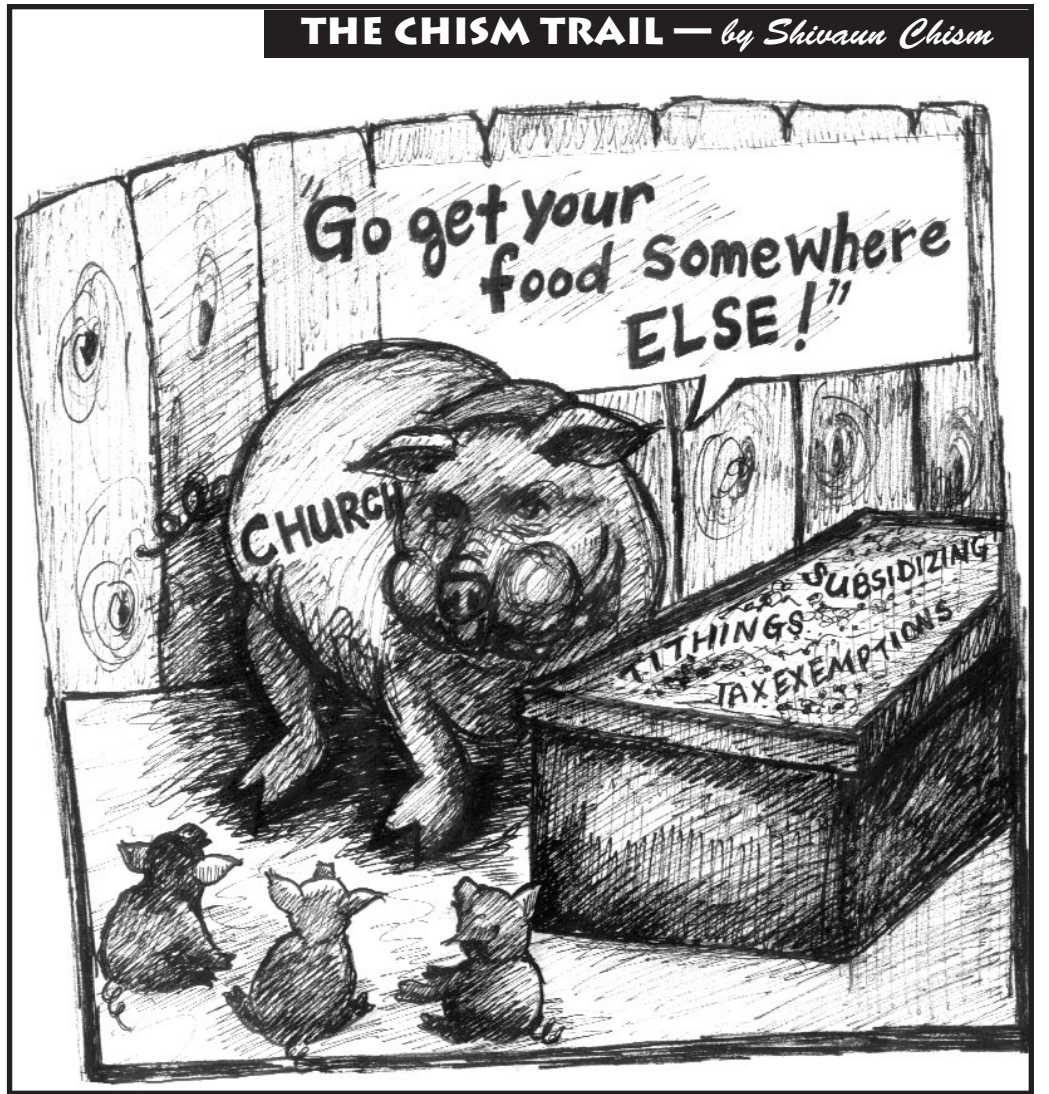
“I keep reading about layoffs — Chrysler, J.C. Penney, Crown books, and more — but never any government agencies! Why not???”

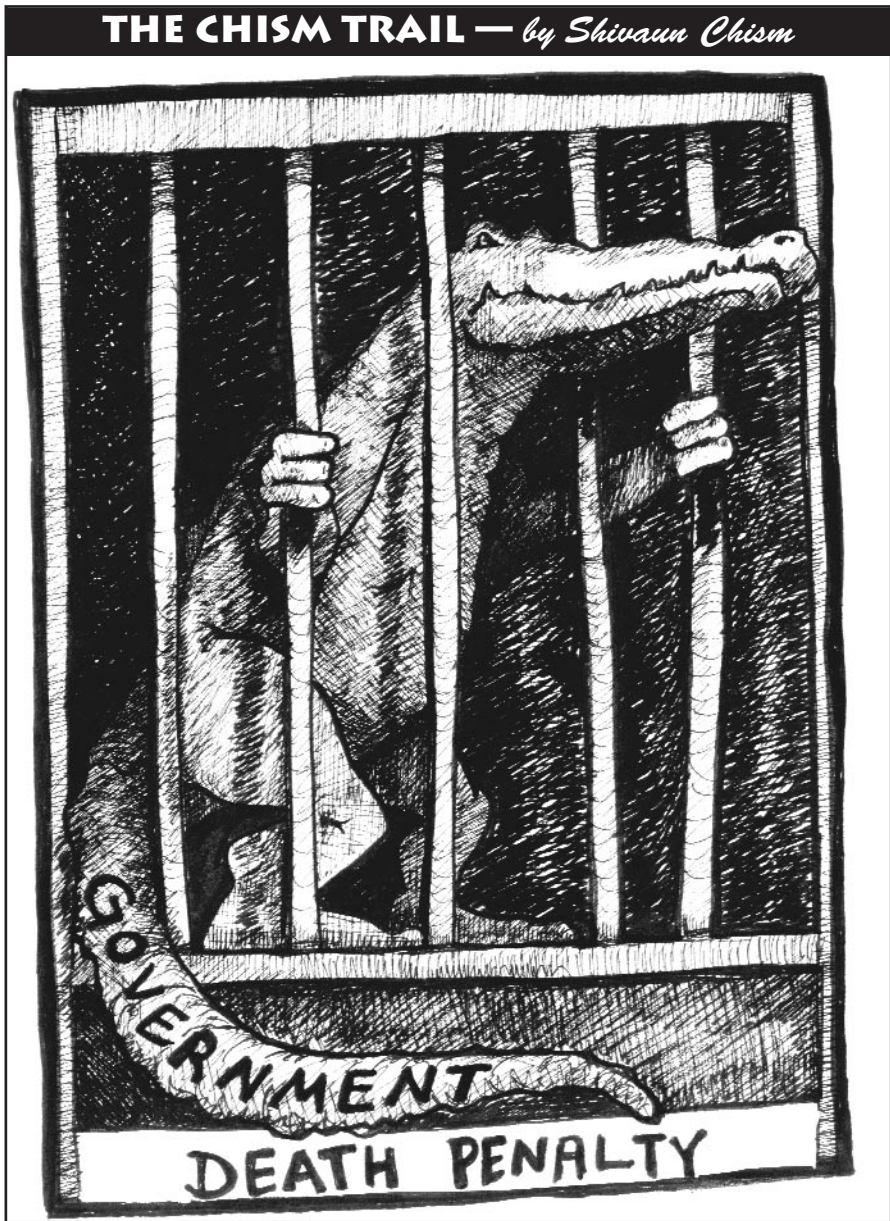

Our suit against inspectors Newe and Freeman is still pending. We want no money, only that they are both fired and pay our court costs.

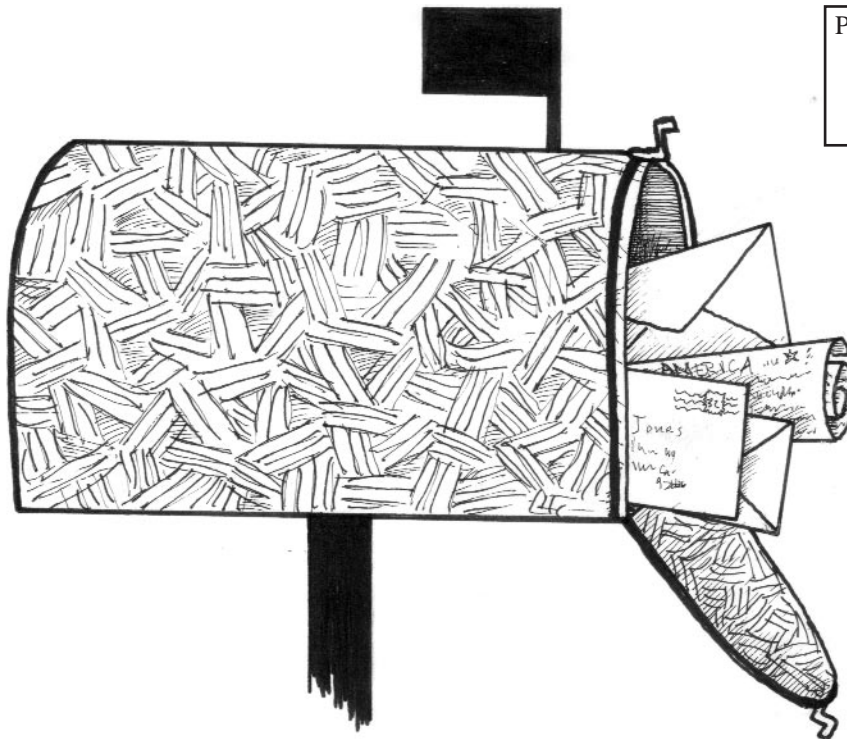
